The Healthcare Management program provides you with the chance to combine your interest in business and healthcare into one career. Graduates of the program possess the required skills and academic knowledge for entry-level positions in healthcare.

Jobs in healthcare management are available in hospitals, physician offices, ambulatory clinics, outpatient surgical centers, long-term care facilities, insurance companies, assisted living facilities, and rehabilitation facilities. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment in the healthcare field is expected to grow faster than average for all occupations through 2024.

Associate of Applied Science Degree

Learn the ins and outs of working in healthcare facilities such as hospitals, physicians' offices, long-term care facilities and rehab centers. The two concentrations of the Healthcare Management A.A.S. program prepare you for a career in healthcare or medical coding.

The **Medical Management** concentration focuses on legal and reimbursement issues specific to healthcare.

The **Medical Coding** concentration focuses on interpreting medical documentation to assign diagnosis and procedure codes applying proper coding guidelines.
