YuJa: Redesigned Mobile App Available

The YuJa mobile app is free for Android and iOs devices, allowing you and your students to access and view the media content in your channels. This spring, the YuJa mobile app has been completely redesigned from the ground up to be faster and compatible with newer devices (iOS and Android). New features include:

• Access Your My Media Library on the Go: The new "My Media" tab allows you to view all content in your collection and upload new media no matter where you are or what device you use.

- Redesigned Media Player: View multi-stream videos, toggle captions, and move 10 seconds forward or backward.
- New Channels View: All videos within a channel will be visible so that you can access all content published to your courses.
- Global Search Function: Search and access all your media content.
 Added support for searching special characters.

• Open Links and Documents:
Within the mobile app, open hyperlinks, access PDF files, Excel spreadsheets, Word documents, PowerPoint presentations and more!

Coming Soon to the YuJa Enterprise Video Platform


This cloud-based platform allows you to securely create, manage, discover, collaborate, and stream video content to your students across any device. The upcoming release includes some exciting new features that will help instructors make more effective use of their media channels. Updates include:

- Real-Time Recording Status Updates for Captures: New placeholder states for capture session status, such as Recording, Paused, and Uploading to Cloud make it easy to see which stage your software capture is in the process.
- **Rewind Live Streams:** A revised live-stream media player provides integrated DVR-style rewind controls. You can rewind the live stream and review the content, then jump back to live at the click of a button!
- New Generative AI Capacity: YuJa now offers generative AI capacity to create multilingual dubbing in 10 languages. Content creators can use AI credits to autogenerate multi-lingual language tracks for their videos.


Panorama Digital Accessibility Platform

YuJa's Panorama Accessibility Platform helps instructors design and create more accessible content for their courses. The latest release offers some useful enhancements.


• Version Histories: Instructors now can view and restore documents to previous versions. When documents are updated in a course, Panorama will preserve the previous version of the document so that you can access the history of prior versions and restore to an earlier version if needed.



- Heightened Detection for HTML Pages: New accessibility checks for web pages help identify issues such as missing table headers, small target sizes for buttons and links, and adjacent links containing the same link.
- New To-Do List: Do you have course documents that you know you need to adjust, but don't have the time just now? Add them to your To-Do List in Panorama and enhance them when you have time. Changes made to your To-Do List documents are automatically reflected in your course, and vice-versa. To add a document to your To-Do List, simply open the document in D2L, access the accessibility report, and then click on the ellipsis (3 dots) near the top and select "Add To My To-Do List".



The next time you open Panorama from your course, you'll see that the document has been added to your list.
