John E. Mayfield Endowed Scholarship

The John E. Mayfield Endowed Scholarship is made possible through the Mayfield Endowment Fund set up with the Nashville State Community College Foundation. The goal of this Scholarship is to attract and retain students from Cheatham County, Tennessee. Each recipient will receive a maximum award equal to \$400 per semester. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

To qualify, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form through your myNSCC. You must complete this form each year by May 31st. We recommend that you submit your form early. Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-awarded basis until funds are expended.

## This scholarship is awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must be residents of Cheatham County, Tennessee.
- Applicants must be enrolled in an Associate Degree program at NSCC and must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours in remedial/developmental or college-level courses. Priority will be given to students enrolled full-time (twelve or more credit hours).
- First-time freshman must have a minimum 2.5 high school grade point average.
- Previously enrolled /currently enrolled NSCC students or transfer students must have earned a minimum of twelve credit hours (inclusive of remedial/developmental coursework) with a grade point average of 2.5.
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- Applicants must also provide all necessary information needed to complete their financial aid file as requested by the NSCC Financial Aid Office. Awards will be contingent upon the determination of financial need.
- Applicants must maintain satisfactory academic progress as measured for federal Title IV Programs.

Recipients of the John E. Mayfield Endowed Scholarship must maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative grade point average (inclusive of remedial/developmental coursework) at NSCC for each semester the scholarship is received to remain eligible for renewal. Recipients must also complete all credit hours that they are enrolled in at the point of payment of funds.

Students who receive the Mayfield Endowed Scholarship in the fall semester must continue to meet the criteria listed above to remain eligible for the spring disbursement of the scholarship.

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
