The NSCC Foundation Culinary Arts Scholarship is made possible by contributions from local businesses with an interest in promoting culinary education. Recipients are awarded a maximum of \$2000 each year. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

To qualify, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form through your myNSCC. You must complete this form each year by May 31st. We recommend that you submit your form early. Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants on a first-come, first-awarded basis until funds are expended.

This is scholarship awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must be pursuing an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts at NSCC.
- Applicants must have completed at least 30 hours toward the Culinary Arts Associate's Degree, exclusive of transfer coursework.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.75 cumulative grade point average.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six credit hours.
- Applicants must agree to volunteer at the Tennessee Flavors event that occurs in the Spring.
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
