The Nashville State Community College Foundation Randy Rayburn Culinary Arts Scholarship is made possible by contributions from local businessman, Randy Rayburn. Recipients are awarded the equivalent of full-time, instate registration fee assessment based on 12 credit hours plus textbooks not to exceed \$2,575 per semester. Awards will be made contingent upon available funding.

To qualify, please submit your NSCC Financial Aid and Scholarship Form through your myNSCC. You must complete this form each year by May 31st. We recommend that you submit your form early.

This scholarship is awarded to qualified applicants based on the following criteria:

- Applicants must be pursuing an Associate Degree in Culinary Arts at NSCC.
- Applicants must have achieved sophomore status.
- Applicants must have a minimum 2.50 cumulative grade point average.
- Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of twelve credit hours.
- Applicants must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

Applicable maintenance fee/tuition refunds will be credited to the scholarship except in cases when the student is also receiving federal Title IV benefits and totally withdraws. In such cases, the refund is credited back to the appropriate program(s) according to the NSCC "Return of Title IV Funds" Policy.
